Health Sciences Assistant/Associate Clinical Professor – Correctional Behavioral Health. The University of California, Davis, Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences is recruiting for two Health Sciences Assistant/Associate Clinical Professors in the clinician/teaching series to serve as teaching attendings in its jail psychiatric program to which forensic fellows, residents and medical students are assigned. The applicant will be evaluating and treating patients who are in custody at the jail. The applicant(s) will also be supervising general psychiatry residents and medical students with their adult cases on the inpatient unit and in the general population. The jail psychiatric service is a highly valued clinical rotation site for medical students and residents because of the diversity of the patient population and the high quality teaching. Experience in teaching and supervising residents and medical students is required. Must be a medical doctor with board certification in general psychiatry and a California Medical license. Completion of ACGME Forensic Psychiatry Fellowship and Forensic Psychiatry Board Certification are preferable. The Department of Psychiatry has approximately 60 residents in six residency training programs and over 90 faculty and staff psychiatrists and psychologists at the UC Davis Medical Center and the Northern California VA Health System. The Department provides a stimulating teaching and academic environment and serves a culturally diverse population.

Applications should be submitted by September 5, 2016, for initial consideration. However, the position will remain open until January 31, 2017.
