CEREBROVASCULAR NEUROLOGIST

The University of California, Davis, Department of Neurology, is seeking two (2) board eligible/certified cerebrovascular neurologists for full time faculty positions in the UC Davis School of Medicine in Sacramento, CA.

These positions are at the Assistant/Associate/Full Professor levels in the Health Sciences Clinical series. UC Davis Medical Center is an advanced primary stroke center primed to become a comprehensive stroke center within the next year. There exists a neurology residency program, neurocritical care ICU, 24 hours/7 day coverage for neuro-endovascular procedures, neurovascular neurosurgery, RN stroke coordinator, and a well-established telestroke/teleneurology network. As a Level 1 Trauma Center UCDHS has the largest catchment area of the academic medical centers in California. UC Davis Medical Center and the Neurology and Neurosurgery department is nationally recognized for quality of patient care and provides clinical, academic, and research leadership in the region.

The faculty member will provide inpatient and outpatient clinical care as well as teaching to medical students and residents. The faculty member will be a key participant in helping to guide the stroke center to the next level. Research is not required but strongly encouraged. There are highly active well-funded research programs and clinical trials in the cerebrovascular field in place.

Candidates must possess an MD or DO degree, be board certified in Neurology by the ABPN, be board certified or board eligible in Vascular Neurology by the ABPN and have the ability to obtain a California medical license. Most successful candidates will be board certified in both Vascular Neurology and board certified or eligible in Neurocritical Care. The level of appointment will be commensurate with credentials.

To receive full consideration, applications must be received by October 8, 2016. Interested applicants should submit: 1) cover letter with a summary of objectives and goals; 2) curriculum vita; and, 3) names of three references including addresses, telephone numbers and email addresses.
