

Internal Medicine Faculty Position (Job ID #39579)

The Florida State University College of Medicine (FSU COM) is seeking an academic internist for a full-time faculty position*, open rank in the Department of Clinical Sciences. A generalist or someone with a Med-Peds or subspecialty training in rheumatology, endocrinology or infectious diseases with primary focus in an outpatient/consultative practice would be considered. This individual will be intimately involved in general educational activities for medical students in an integrated curriculum at the Central campus in Tallahassee. Additional responsibilities include substantial teaching and supervision of general internal medicine residents while staffing the outpatient clinics of the FSU COM Internal Medicine Residency Program located at Tallahassee Memorial HealthCare (TMH). The ability to foster an educational environment conducive to patient-centered, resident and student education and to integrate his/her role as a College of Medicine faculty member at TMH and with community physicians is vital to this position. The individual must demonstrate evidence of experience and/or excellence in medical student and resident education. Scholarly interest and experience in outpatient/community-based clinical and/or health outcomes research is desired. Applicants must have professional goals which are consistent with the mission of this community-based medical school, as described on our website <http://med.fsu.edu>. Requirements include a medical degree, completion of an ACGME-approved Internal Medicine or combined Med-Peds residency program. Board eligibility by the American Board of Internal Medicine, with eventual Board Certification within the first year of hire is anticipated. The individual must possess and/or be eligible for licensure in the State of Florida, federal DEA certification and have either United States Citizenship or Permanent Resident status.

Tallahassee Memorial HealthCare has an award-winning 772-bed acute care hospital with a medical staff of over 570 physicians, spanning over 50 specialties and including certified stroke, chest pain and comprehensive community cancer care centers. Florida State University College of Medicine is located in Tallahassee, the State capital of Florida.
