- Ph.D. degree in epidemiology, biostatistics, or related field with strong methodological training.
- Seven years of faculty experience.
- Demonstrated track record of excellence in teaching graduate level epidemiology courses and mentoring graduate students.
- An outstanding publication record in public health that would warrant appointment at the Associate or Full Professor level.
- Active portfolio of extramurally funded research.
- Demonstrated track record and commitment to applied research in communities, workplaces, health departments, or other non-academic settings.
- Expertise in chronic, non-communicable diseases.
